Broneirion

Broneirion is conveniently located in the beautiful valley of the Severn, eight miles from the market town of Newtown in Powys, Mid Wales. Its peaceful and picturesque location overlooks the village of Llandinam.

The House, set in four acres of grounds, looks particularly beautiful in the spring when the daffodils, azaleas and rhododendrons are in full bloom. The very tall Wellingtonia trees are a noted landmark and the wooded area above the house contains Y Bwthyn 'The Brownie House' originally built as a summerhouse.

Broneirion was built in 1864 and was originally the home of the renowned industrialist, David Davies. The House, Grade II listed, was first used as the Girlguiding Cymru Training Centre in 1946. The 14 Welsh Guiding Counties each generously support Broneirion by decorating and maintaining a bedroom, which is named after the highest point in their county.
